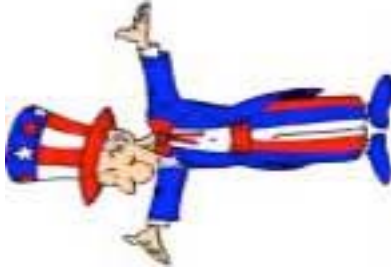


SPARC, QCRC and SPARCL would like to request your participation in our **First Annual Theodore Roosevelt Golf Tournament.**
