Clinton won the popular vote in New York by approx. 1.7 million votes.

In the five counties that encompass NYC, (Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Richmond & Queens) Clinton received well over 2 million more votes than Trump. (Clinton only won 4 of these counties; Trump won Richmond)

Therefore these 5 counties alone, more than accounted for Clinton winning the popular vote in New York.

Similarly, two states swung the NATIONAL popular vote for Clinton:

Clinton won the national popular vote by 2,868,691. If you remove California and New York, Clinton lost the popular vote by 3,138,277. Here are the vote totals:

California	8,753,788	4,483,410	4,270,378
Rest of Country	52,543,604	55,681,881	(3,138,277)
National Total	65,853,516	62,984,825	2,868,691
