	<i>Kelli Ward</i>	Osteopathic physician. AZ state senator 2013 to 2015. Ran against McCain in 2016.
<b>US House, CD 2</b>	<i>Brandon Martin</i>	Army Intelligence officer. Sierra Vista resident since 2006.
	<i>Danny Morales</i>	Naval Reserve officer. AZ certified peace officer. Cochise County reserve deputy.
	<i>Lea Marquez-Peterson</i>	CEO of Tucson Hispanic Chamber since 2009. Former owner of a chain of gas stations and convenience stores.
	<i>Casey Welch</i>	Peace Corps volunteer to Nicaragua. Later with US Agency for Intl. Dev. in Iraq, Afghanistan and Columbia.
	<i>Marilyn Wiles</i>	Retired Federal Senior Executive. Current owner of a management consulting firm.
