Tax Simplification:

Tax all income at the same rate including wages, profits, capital gains, gifts, winnings, ALL income. Allow only three adjustments to income each tax year: 1) Personal exclusion of 15,000 per person or \$30,000 per couple. 2) Deduction for Contributions to IRAs up to \$3,000 per person and 3) Contributions to Health Savings Accounts up to \$2,000 per person. NO OTHER DEDUCTIONS. Tax all income above these exclusions at a flat rate, say 18%. Tax returns could be done on a postcard.

Cut the Federal Budget:

Implement an across the board reduction of 10% per year for the next five years. Give each federal agency a mandate to do more with less. U.S. industry has gone through this successfully. The taxpayers are paying handsome salaries to federal managers. It's time they managed. If anyone questions that there is fraud, waste and abuse in the federal budget, they are totally out of touch.
